Kit List

Scouts are encouraged to pack their own bag just like they would do if they were camping. Below is a list of all the equipment you'll need for each activity too.

Camp

- PJ's
- Teddy
- Wash kit (including toothbrush, toothpaste and wash cloth)
- Water bottle
- Change of clothes for Sunday
- Blanket / sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Tent / blanket fort / den materials

Outdoor Treasure Hunts

- Waterproofs (if needed) and sturdy shoes
- Access to a camera or phone with camera
- Access to a phone with what3words app and maps

- Pancake mixture (makes 10-12):
 - 110g plain flour
 - 2 large eggs
 - 275g semi-skimmed milk (or alternative)
 - a little butter or oil for cooking
- Frying Pan
- Choice of toppings (fresh fruit, sugar, lemon, jam, chocolate spread, syrup etc.)

Dragon Crafts (10:30 Sunday 18th April)

- Used kitchen roll or toilet roll for a shorter dragon
 - To be done in advance: painted/coloured green or covered in green paper
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Tape
- Green, black and red pens or pencils

- 2 sheets of paper (ideally 1 white and 1 green, or 2 white and green pencils/pens)
- Stick on eyes (optional)
